In the intervening moths Bernadette encountered the Blessed Virgin Mary who prayed the Rosary together. Bernadette died as a Sister of Charity in Nevers at the age of 35. This September and October the Relics of St Bernadette will visit every Irish Diocese and some Religious Houses. On Monday 9th September the Relics will be in the Cathedral of SS. Peter & Paul Ennis and on Tuesday 10th September the Relics will be in Our Lady of Lourdes Church Silvermines Co Tipperary. More details later.
