Saint Vincent wanted people to treat those in need with "care and a loving concern". He died in 1850, leaving a legacy that continues to inspire people worldwide today. The Pallottines Fathers and Brothers are located here in Ireland in both Thurles and Dublin and this year are visiting every parish in the Killaloe Diocese promoting their mission.
